ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

MISSION

The purpose of the Foundation is to award grants to advance the education of the general public about Indian art. Current priorities are placed on aiding the buying and conservation of objects and supporting students' exhibitions.

WHO MAY APPLY

Both individuals and organisations who require assistance with academic projects concerned with Indian art, or with exhibitions, lectures and symposia on the subject.

EXAMPLES OF GRANTS

Typically grants vary between £5,000 - £8,000. Trustees retain the right to use discretion to provide more or less funding.

- A scholarship to assist with research into traditionally painted Kalamkari fabric, including a secondment at Cornell University, New York
- Sponsorship of the ClimbK2 conference in both 2016 and 2018 in Mumbai attended by 795 delegates involved in Indian Visual arts.
- Funds to attend a conference. Note: the grant will be approved upon consideration of the abstract and provided the Board receive official confirmation by the conference organising committee that the paper has been accepted.

PROCESS:

Applications should be submitted no later than 12 weeks before any funds are required, as this allows time for references to be accessed and any questions to be answered. As applications which do not meet the minimum timescale cannot be considered, they should be made as early as possible.

- An application requires two referees to support an application. The referees should be able to
 validate the reasons for the application and the potential benefits arising from it. Both references
 must be included with the application.
- The application requires a detailed project proposal including a timeline for consideration.
- Confirmation of access to collections must be provided where appropriate.

CONDITIONS

The making and level of award will be entirely at the discretion of the Dallapiccola Foundation, and the Board reserves the right not to enter into dialogue or correspondence with unsuccessful applicants.

Where a grant is approved the recipient must provide acknowledgement of the support given by the Dallapiccola Foundation in publication or lecture up to one year after the grant has finished. Grants in support of conference papers require the Dallapiccola Foundation to be acknowledged both at the conference and within any related publication.

Reports from successful application are expected.
